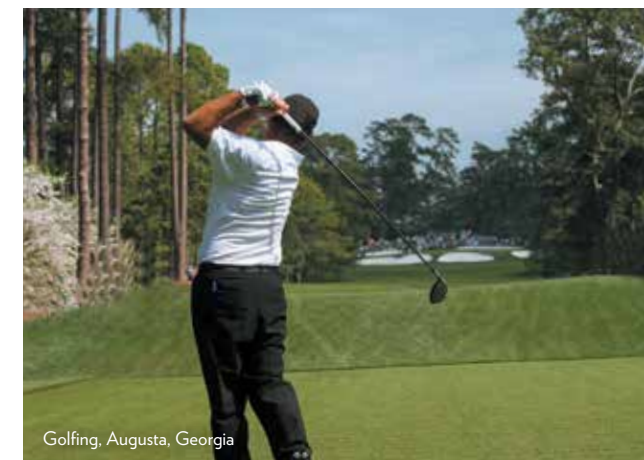

### What does "integrated wellness" mean at Miraval?

Honoring the triad of mind, body and spirit is the bedrock on which we've built our programming.

### What does going out of your comfort zone look like for guests?

### BOUND FOR BUENOS AIRES

Whether you begin or end your voyage in Buenos Aires, you'll instantly be mesmerized by sights like the striking façade of Teatro Colón, the famous names buried in Recoleta Cemetery and the brilliantly painted buildings in the La Boca district. When evening falls in the bohemian neighborhood of San Telmo, outdoor lanterns glow outside of historic bars and tango cafés. A spontaneous dance session and other live entertainment might break out in Plaza Dorrego. Feast late into the night on delicious *asado* (Argentine barbecue), empanadas and *milanesa* (breaded and fried meat) along with glasses of ruby-red malbec.

### ▲ JOURNEY TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH

Ushuaia and Punta Arenas are the gateways to the Antarctic. From here you'll make your way to some of the world's most breathtaking vistas, entering Tierra del Fuego National Park, which was carved by ancient glaciers. Photograph sapphire lakes framed by snow-capped mountains and see the stunning coastline along the Beagle Channel. Aboard the End of the World Train, embrace the once-in-a-lifetime chance to experience the southernmost point of the park as you ride over four miles through picturesque valleys.

### MORE ASHORE

Did you know that it's perfectly normal to dine at 10 p.m. in South America? With Princess More Ashore overnight stays, you get the chance to experience local life long after the sun sets and other ships have departed. Amid this unspoiled scenery, keep your eyes open for Peale's dolphins that may swim alongside your ship and seabirds looking down from above.

Trace the very same route that only the bravest seafarers once dared: Cape Horn, the northern boundary of the Drake Passage where the Pacific and Atlantic oceans meet. This legendary route leads you toward views of glaciers that rise before you and jagged icebergs whose enormity is shrouded by frigid waters.

During your voyage, learn insightful facts about this wild and remote landscape where penguins and sea lions cluster on rocky islets, and seabirds like the Cape pigeon and Antarctic tern soar overhead.

# SOLAR MAXIMUM

*The northern lights are brighter than ever in Canada's winter wonderland.*

Once in about 11 years, a celestial event known as the solar maximum takes over the skies. As the sun's magnetic activity peaks, sunspots multiply and magnetic field lines create bursts of energy. Solar flares and coronal mass ejections shoot forth energized particles that can reach Earth's magnetic field, colliding with the gasses in our atmosphere. Against a clear and dark night sky, the northern

lights (aurora borealis) begin to dance in a brilliant kaleidoscope of bright green, red, blue, and purplish hues.

That time is now, and the place is Canada. The lights that appear are brighter, more fiery and more frequent than we've seen in over a decade, and we can arrange a multitude of ways to experience them in all their dazzling beauty.

### NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

This is one of the best places in the world to see the northern lights — visible for up to 240 nights a year! Mid-November through early April are peak times, but you'll also have luck from late summer to early fall.

Beluga whales in summer, polar bears in fall and northern lights in winter? Churchill, Manitoba, is a dream destination on the edge of the Arctic. January through March are the peak months to see the lights in this region.

Getting to Churchill is part of the experience, as there are no roads that lead there. Take the train or fly from Winnipeg to the shores of the

Hudson Bay, where every day brings a different adventure. Capture inspirational photographs of polar bears shrouded by the snow and ice, admire time-worn Inuit carvings and artifacts, and listen to lectures about the Manitoba landscape from insightful experts. An evening snowshoe adventure through the boreal forest reveals the northern lights streaming overhead. At the Churchill Northern Studies Centre, you're welcome to wear your pajamas in a heated dome or venture outdoors to an elevated viewing platform.
